

MCGINNIS LAKE DISTRICT MEETING

December 3, 2022

The May 28, 2022 minutes were passed out at the meeting. A motion was made by Jerry Poehler to accept the minutes as written and seconded by Steve Zoulek The motion passed.

Barry Berndsen read the Treasurer's report. The beginning cash balance was \$26,783.72. Total Cash inflows were \$0. Cash outflows were \$19.32 for Barry Berndsen (Copies and postage). \$111.67 (Office supplies and postage) December 3, 2022 Cash Balance was \$26,652.73. Jerry Poehler made a motion to accept the Treasurers report as read, and it was seconded by Steve Zoulek. The motion passed.

Old Business

Lake Maintenance Activities: The dam got clogged up at the intake in mid-October. Many residents' piers were floating around. A diver came from Adams County Land and Water and unclogged it. As of Nov 1st, the water level had dropped 14 inches back to its usual level. Now it has climbed back up again to about half the level of what it was before, so it is still partially clogged. Barry Berndsen emailed and called Dustin from Adams County Land and Water, but they have not responded. Jerry Poehler said he will reach out to Dustin.
